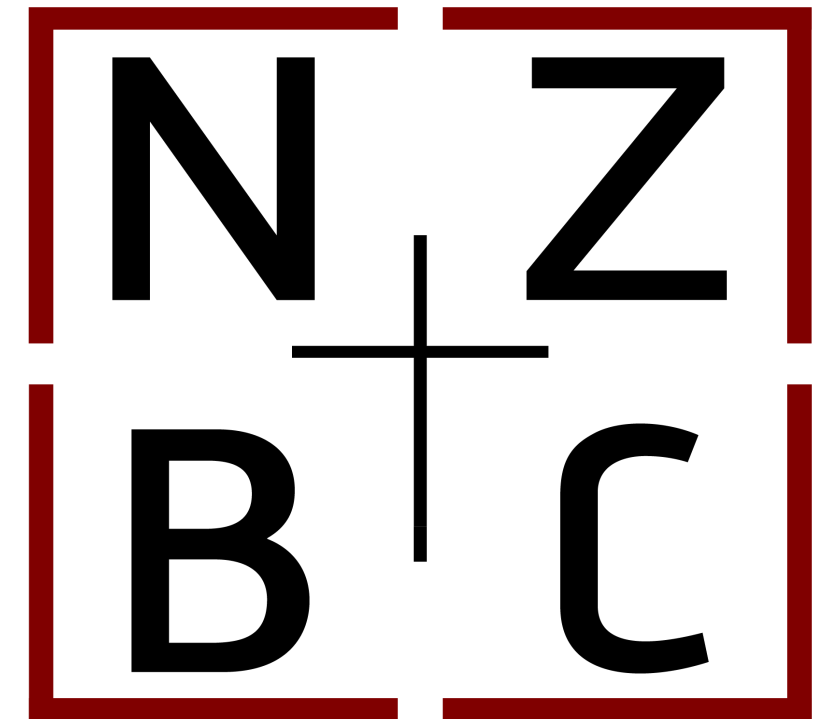

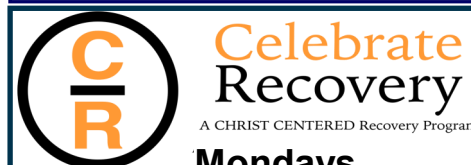

### Children's Church Drop-Off and Pick-Up Procedure

1. Children's Church is for children 4 years old – 2<sup>nd</sup> grade.
2. Register your child during fellowship time in the sanctuary foyer.
3. At registration, you will receive two name tags:
  - a. Place one name tag on your child's shirt
  - b. The person picking up the child will need the second name tag at the time of pick-up.
4. The children will be dismissed to go to Children's Church at the beginning of the sermon. The children will walk to the FMC with the Children's Church leader.
5. Please pick up your child from FMC room #112 immediately following the service. Your child will only be dismissed to the person who has the pick-up name tag.
