- VBS begins at 6:00 pm each night. Please arrive by 5:45 pm each night to greet students as they arrive.
 - Children ages 3 years old - 5th grade will begin each night in the sanctuary for the opening rally.
 - Babies, One Year Olds, and 2 Year Olds will go directly to their classrooms and do not attend Opening Rally.
- **Class Signs**
 - Each group leader (3 Year Olds - 5th Grade) will need to make a sign displaying their group name and color. (Ex: 1st Grade Red)
 - The signs are usually made from poster board and a dowel/yard stick.
 - The signs will be used when taking class pictures and to help children locate their group leader during rotations.
- **Opening Rally**
 - Each group will have an assigned pew where they are to sit together.
 - Bring your sign with you each night.
 - Give each child their name tag as they arrive. They should continue to wear their name tags throughout the night.
 - Take attendance each night during the Opening Rally.
 - Class rosters will be on the pew each night.
 - Mark students who are present and leave the completed roster on the pew for the Records Team to pick up.
 - Please note any changes (Ex: new students) on the roster
 - We will be collecting an offering for the Louisiana Baptist Children's Home during the week. You can assist students in bringing their offering to the assigned buckets (Boys vs. Girls) as they arrive during Opening Rally
 - Please wait to be dismissed by the worship leader.
- **Rotations**
 - Rotations include Bible Study, Music, Snack, Recreation, Crafts, & Missions
 - Each group follows its own rotation schedule. Locations for each rotation are listed on the rotation schedule.
 - Stay with your group throughout the night. Please do not leave your group unattended. Assist as needed and do your best to help ensure children stay on task, listen, and are respectful of the different rotation leaders.
 - There is built-in transition time between the different rotations. You can use this time for bathroom breaks or to take pictures.
 - During snack, please enter through the gym hallway doors (by the drink machine) and wait to be directed to a table. You will need to tell the hostess the number of children in your group each night. When exiting, use the gym's back door. Snack time is also your time to eat, so please take turns with your helpers at the food line.
 - You will alternate between crafts and recreation each night, so be sure to pay close attention to this note on your schedule. Friday night is Free Choice, allowing children to choose between crafts and recreation. If some of your group wants to go to crafts and others to recreation, please make sure an adult accompanies both groups.
- **Pictures**
 - Each child will have their picture taken during the week to go with the picture frame that they make in Crafts.
 - Pictures are taken in the Senior Adult Ladies Sunday School Class in the sanctuary foyer.
 - Please try to have your class pictures taken by Wednesday night. You can use transition time or rotation time to take your pictures. The only time that you cannot use to have your class pictures taken is during Bible Study.
- **Closing Rally/Dismissal**
 - Have your group sit together on your assigned pew during the closing rally.
 - Parents/guardians will need to wait until the end of the closing rally to pick up their children
 - Check each child out at dismissal by confirming that the security code on their name tag matches that on the card of the person picking them up. Do not let children leave with someone who cannot present a security card with the correct code.

- Collect name tags as the children leave. Name tags are reused each night.
- The name tags will need to be turned back in on Friday night to be used again next year.
- Please do not leave until all the children in your group have been picked up.
- Please find the VBS Director or a staff member if there are any issues during dismissal.
